

HASTINGS CONTEMPORARY

Hastings Contemporary launched in July 2019 when we moved away from being Jerwood Gallery. Hastings Contemporary is a new, independent modern and contemporary art gallery for Hastings, and reflects the town's independent spirit, drawing on the rich artistic heritage of Hastings and the South East and engages with the town's growing creative community. Hastings Contemporary's expanded programme explores all forms of modern and contemporary art, and continues to champion the medium of painting, for which it has built a strong reputation.

The building designed by HAT Projects, is a sensitive response to its context of the fishing beach, listed net huts and medieval Old Town. The gallery has received a number of architectural awards including a RIBA National Award, Civic Trust Award, Sussex Heritage Trust Award and reached the mid list for the Stirling Prize.

The gallery features:

- The main gallery, a large contemporary space for our exhibitions programme
- Seven smaller galleries which display a continuation of our contemporary exhibitions
- External courtyard
- Webbe's at Hastings Contemporary, our first-floor café with stunning views of the sea
- Shop
- Studio Space
